Vocal selections from Conservatory syllabi must be performed in the prescribed key for Level 8 to Open repertoire. All other vocal selections may be transposed.

Competitors are required to limit their performance to three verses only.

It is required that anyone wishing to qualify for a scholarship perform in TWO or more solo classes in the same discipline.
